

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE WHITEFISH DUCK DERBY



Presented by The Whitefish Community Foundation (the "Foundation"), to benefit The Annual Community Grants Fund of the Foundation.

1. Ducks will be dropped simultaneously into the Whitefish River at the Baker Street pedestrian bridge. Races will begin at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 15, 2010 starting with the Kids Great Rubber Duck Dash with 200+ duck entries, followed by the Battle of the Big Duck with maximum of 500 duck entries, and last, the Lucky Ducky Derby with 5000+ duck entries and the Mixed Breed Derby. All races will be approximately 150 yards long. The Foundation reserves the right to lengthen or shorten the race.
2. All purchased ("adopted") ducks will remain in the possession of the Foundation.
3. Once the ducks are dropped, they are on their own. The public may not attempt to free a duck that is stuck. Official Duck Wranglers will attempt to free ducks that are stuck with paddles and rakes if deemed necessary by the Race Officials. No hand contact is allowed.
4. Each duck is coded with an assigned number relating to the number on the official adoption certificate. A Participant may adopt multiple ducks. Each duck will have a separate number. The person's name that is registered to the first duck in order of finish will be awarded prizes. A list of prizes can be found on the Foundation website: www.whitefishcommunityfoundation.org.
5. The Foundation reserves the right to substitute prizes.
6. Entry Forms ("adoption papers") must be filled out by all Participants prior to the race and must be received by Race officials prior to the beginning of the race to be eligible to win prizes. Participants assume the risk of non-delivery of any entries to the Foundation or Race officials.
7. Winners will be announced following the races at Riverside Park, Sunday, August 15 at 4:00 p.m. *Participants need not be present to win.* Winners will be notified by Email or telephone. A list of race winners will be posted on the Foundation website. Winners are responsible for all shipping and handling fees for prizes.
8. Any and all taxes and similar fees are the sole responsibility of the participating winners. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided in lieu of the designated prizes.
9. By entering, the Participants release the Foundation, directors, employees, and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to race outcome and prizes.
10. By entering, Participants who win a prize consent to the promotional use of their names without compensation.
11. Odds of winning depend on the number of entries per race.
12. This is a raffle event and is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.
13. The format of the race and the determination of race winners will be audited and verified by an appointed representative. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by the Foundation and its judgment is final.

15. If the Foundation determines, in its sole discretion, that the race cannot occur at the scheduled time for any reason, then the Foundation reserves the right to postpone the race to another date and time by public announcement thereof.

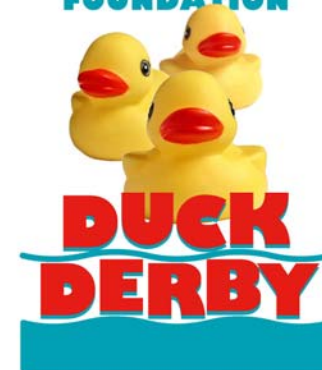
